Introduction

Thank you for purchasing Lovego Portable Oxygen Concentrator! This unit produces different oxygen purity range from 40%-93% with the adjustable continuous flow from 1 to 5 liters per minute. Lovego can be used with wall power, car cigarette lighter and lithium battery.

This User manual will acquaint you with Lovego Oxygen Concentrator. There is battery manual about how to use the machine with battery and car inverter in details. Important Safety Rules

When using electrical products, especially for children, basic safety precautions should always be followed. Read all instructions before using. Important information is highlighted by these terms:

A DANGER

Urgent safety information for hazards that will cause serious injury and danger to your life

A DANGER

To reduce the risk of serious or fatal injury from electrical shock:

- 1. Do not use while bathing.
- 2. Do not place the product where can be splashed liquid or fall into bathtub, water or other liquid.
- 3. In the event of unit falling into water, do not reach for the machine. Turn off the home power immediately then send it to dealer or our authorized service center for examination and repair.

A WARNING

- 1. Check the electric rating in the unit label and wall outlet before connecting power cord.
- 2. Keep all electrical cords away from heated surfaces.
- 3. Do not operate this unit if it:
 - has been dropped or knocked heavily.
 - has been splashed liquid.
 - has a damaged cord or plug.
 - is not working properly

AWARNING

This device produces high levels of oxygen, which promotes rapid burning. Do not allow smoking or open flames within 5 feet of this device and any oxygen delivery accessory. Do not use oil, grease or petroleum-based products on or near the unit. Disconnect the power cord from the electrical outlet before you clean or repair the unit.

A WARNING

If this unit is turned on but not in use, do not leave the Headset under covering or chair cushions. The oxygen will make the material flammable. Set the on/off power switch to the off position when the Oxygen Concentrator is not in use.

A WARNING

Do not remove cover of the machine! Only your dealer or our authorized technician should remove the cover.

A WARNING

Do not use extension cords with this unit. Do not overload wall outlet.

A CAUTION

Do not block the ventilation located on the back of unit.

Getting Start

Open the unit packing, check the content and make sure the following components are enclosed: Lithium Ion battery, Battery charger, Car Inverter, potable bag (optional), AC power supply and DC cord, Headstyle oxygen pipe, Earphone oxygen pipe, Bacteria Filter, Humidifier , Humidifier connecting tube, mobile cart(optional).






How to Operate Your Lovego POC

- 1. Familiarize yourself with this unit.
- 2. Place unit on a stable flat surface which is clean and free of dust.
- 3. Plug power cord into electrical outlet.

A NOTE

Before attempting to start a cold unit, let the unit reach the room temperature for 30 minutes.

4. Press the O₂ On/Off button start the unit.



- 5. Set the running time by pressing the Time set +or- Button as following.
 - A. Press the Button Time set + that can increase one hour per time. .
 - B. Press the Button Time set first time that can decrease 30minutes per time.
 - C. Without any press on time +/- after you turn on the machine, the unit will be on 24/7 continuous mode.

6. Connect the oxygen Tube to the Oxygen Outlet of Oxygen Concentrator Unit.

oxygen meter

7. Put the humidifier with pure water if the air is dry for breath.

oxygen outlet

- 8. Adjust the outflow by rotate the oxygen meter from 0-5LPM.
- 9. If you want to run oxygen anion, press the anion button, it can work separately to fresh the room.
- 10. If you will not use the unit in a period of time, remove the power cord from electrical outlet.

How to operate with battery and in the car



- 1. Connect the adapter (car inverter) with car cigarette lighter, then connected with electric code.
- 2. Connect the battery with the Adapter (car inverter), then connected with electric cord.
- 3. Turn on the machine, it will work. The battery can last 61minutes after the full charge.
- 4. Don't use the battery when charging.
- 5. Learn more battery specification in the battery manual.

Maintenance



A DANGER

Do not attempt to open or remove cabinet. If service is required, return unit to a qualified equipment provider or an authorized service center. Opening or tampering with the unit will void warranty.


Turn off the Unit and remove the Power Cord before maintenance.

Clean the Cabinet

- 1. Disconnect the Oxygen Concentrator Unit from all external power sources.
- 2. Wipe the cabinet with a clean cloth with any commercial (bacterial-germicidal) disinfectant.

Air Intake Filter Change

- 1. Disconnect the Oxygen Concentrator Unit from all external power sources.
- 2. Open the Air Intake Cover.
- 3. Take out the Air Intake Filter.
- 4. Replace a new Air Intake Filter.
- 5. The Air Intake Filter should be changed every 3000 hours working.
